Poster Guidelines

1. Basic Information

Eligibility

The contest is open to all IGNOU learners and alumni. Enrolment number must be mentioned on each entry. All entries should be submitted on an individual basis. No shared work is allowed.

Entry Limit

Only one poster per student.

Entry Deadline

Entries must be submitted to the respective Regional Centre, IGNOU by Wednesday, February 15, 2023.

2. Poster Requirements

Objective

Ignite minds of IGNOU students and alumni to think creatively for organic solutions for the issues and challenges in the following thematic areas:

Sub-Thematic areas:

- No poverty/ Zero hunger
- Good health and well being
- Clean water and sanitation
- Sustainable cities and community/ sustainable agriculture
- Affordable, reliable, sustainable and modern energy

Poster Size

Poster can be horizontal or vertical, of A3 size (29.7 cm x 42.0cm)sheet with margins (0.5 inches) as per the following template:

Prizes for the best entries

- Top 3 (three) entries at each Regional Centre to receive a Certificate of Merit.
- Certificate of participation for each entry will be given by respective Regional Centre.

Rules for Poster Making Competition:

- Each Participant can submit only one Poster.
- The poster must be made on the A3 size (29.7 cm x 42.0cm) sheet with margins (0.5 inches) drawn with black pen/marker.
- Poster can be made using pencil, crayon, watercolour, oil paint, etc.
- It should be original, and handmade. Posters copied from any other source will be out rightly rejected.
- The topic of poster and theme should be clearly mentioned at the Top Margin of the Poster.
- Any kind of plagiarism or any explicit content in the poster shall not be entertained atany cost and the participant will be disqualified. **Self-declaration of originality** of poster should be attached with the poster.
- The non-compliance of any of the above points will lead to immediate disqualification.
- The decision will be taken by experts and their decision will be final. No further queries in this regard will be entertained.
- By submitting your poster, you are giving the right to use your poster to IGNOU.
- The organizing team reserves the right to change or modify any of the rules.

• The last date to send your entries is February 15, 2023.

Judgement Criteria:

Scoring will be done on basis of the following criteria with emphasis on neat and clean work as well as creativity of the poster. Judgement will be based on:

- Relevance to the theme
- Originality
- Artistic composition and design
- Creativity and innovativeness
- Message conveyed by the poster
- Effectiveness in communicating the intended message

Eligibility

Entry Limit

Only one essay per student.

Entry Deadline

Entries must be submitted to the respective Regional Centre, IGNOU by Wednesday, February 15, 2023.

Word Limit

The essay should be within 2000-2500 words in handwritten or typed. It should not exceed the word limit or else, would lead to disqualification.

Medium of Essay

The essays can be submitted in any Indian language including English.

Prizes for the best entries

- Top 3 (three) entries at each Regional Centre to receive a Certificate of Merit.
- Certificate of participation for each entry will be given by respective Regional Centre.

Guidelines

- 1. The competition is open for learners and alumni of IGNOU.
- 2. Each participant can send only one entry.
- 3. The entry should be original. Entries copied from any source will not be considered under the contest.
- 4. Please note that the Essay must be original and should not violate Copyright Act. Any kind of plagiarism or any explicit content in the essay shall not be entertained at any cost and the participant will be disqualified. Self-declaration of originally of essay should be attached with the essay.
- 5. No requests relating to claims of re-evaluation of the entries will be considered.
- 6. The decision of the committee will be final and binding to all the entries.
- 7. At any stage of evaluation, if an entry is found to violate the guidelines, the entry will be removed from evaluation process without giving any intimation.
- 8. The essay should be in the following format:

The essay should contain the following components:

- (i) Introduction
- (ii) Description of the issues/problems pertaining to the sub thematic area
- (iii) Role of S&T in addressing these issues/problems
- (iv) Innovative interventions in these areas
- (v) S&T enabled way forward
- (vi) Conclusion

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Guidelines for submitting Ideas for Ideathon

The selected ideas will be displayed during National Science Day celebration at the Regional Centres and School of Sciences, IGNOU. It would also be circulated in IGNOU diginews.

By participating in this Ideathon, you would be able to show your talent, test your ideas, connect with mentors and, challenge yourself to think innovatively. It would, help you to enhance your social and emotional learning, while boosting your competitive spirit. You will also receive training in entrepreneurship skills and related hard and soft skills to develop your idea into a business plan and them to convert it into an innovative product or service.

How to Think of an Idea?

- 1. Think of problems or challenges faced by you or the society in any of the above mentioned theme areas.
- 2. Think of an innovative idea as a solution for the problem.
- 3. Give a detailed description and roadmap/blue print on how your idea will work as a solution to the problem.
- 4. Make sure that the idea is your original idea and is new. In case a similar idea already exists, then highlight the newness of your idea.
